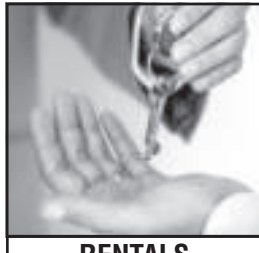

Tractor fest Saturday

Wood Park in Hoosick Falls will be the site of the Walter A. Wood Tractor and Agriculture Show tomorrow, Saturday, Oct. 5, from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Hoosick Falls will celebrate the history of farming and agriculture in the community with tractors of all brands, sizes and running power.

Hit and miss engines will be puffing away along with many displays related to the Walter A. Wood Mowing and Reaping Machine Company, a major employer in the Hoosick Falls area in the late 1800s that shipped reapers and mowers and other types of farm equipment all around the world.

The show was started six years ago by amateur historian Kevin O'Malley of Hoosick Falls. "My great grandfather worked at the Wood Company," he said, "and I wanted to start a festival to honor the company and keep the Wood name alive."

The festival takes place in Wood Park, named for the industrialist whose mansion was nearby.

"Attendance has increased through the years," said O'Malley, "and it looks like we'll have the biggest show this year as far as vendors and tractors are concerned."

Tractors of all types will be on display, as will be Walter A. Wood mowers and reapers bought and refurbished by fans of Wood Company products. "I'll have a few mowers and a rake that I'll bring for the display," said O'Malley.

The day also will include the Burton Luke tractor parade at noon, named for a beloved local farmer.

"Last year we had about 70 tractors in the parade," said Hoosick Township Historical Society director Joyce Brewer, whose organization began working with O'Malley on the tractor show last year. "Last year, we had someone riding his John Deere lawn mower in the parade, and the tractor sizes went up from there," she laughed. "You'll see a lot of antique tractors in the parade."

Vendors will include dairies, farm stands, maple producers, the local 4-H and more. "People don't realize all that is being produced by our local farms," said Brewer, "so we're happy that Sheffer's Grassland Dairy will be here, along with Berle Farm that produces organic artisanal cheese, Cornell's Farm Stand with their amazing apple cider donuts and the list goes on," she said.

Activities for kids will include a giant corn pit - "It's like a sand box except with shelled corn," said Brewer - a design-a-pumpkin booth, hay rides through the village and more.
